On the subsequent advance of the Macedonian king, Taxiles accompanied him with a force of 5, men and took part in the battle of the Hydaspes River. Two years Alexander the Great he commanded the left wing at the Battle of Chaeroneain which Philip defeated the allied Greek states, and displayed personal courage in breaking the Sacred Band of Thebes, an elite military corps composed of pairs of lovers. Upon his return he found that many of the satraps he had entrusted with rule had abused their power and so executed them as well as those who had vandalized Alexander the Great tomb of Cyrus the Great at the old capital city of Pasargadae.
